WHAT WE HAVE DONE IN 2010!

JANUARY: Your Holly Park Homeowner's Association got off to a great start! On January 31st, the Safety Committee participated in the Service Provider's Fair at the Hawthorne Memorial Center, by hosting a table and demonstrating tools and equipment everyone should have on hand in the event of a disaster.

FEBRUARY: On Saturday February 13, 2010, several members of the Holly Park Homeowner's Association met with Sgt. Robbie Williams for a Neighborhood Watch meeting. After a brief discussion, we had a Citizens' Patrol on 115th Place and contacted 19 of our neighbors, giving them information about City of Hawthorne telephone numbers to contact for various services and about the WeTip Hotline for anonymous reports about crime. That number is 1-800-78-crime. With Sgt. Williams' help, we also conducted a community survey concerning perception of police services in Holly Park and received a 79% positive response.
